^{*} Relaxation of upper age limit: The upper age limit will be relaxable for SC, ST candidates by 5 years and for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates by 3 years. For candidates belonging to Persons with Disability (PwBD) category having minimum 40% disability will get 10 (ten) years relaxation in addition to the relaxation applicable to SC/ST/OBC mentioned above.

2. TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT & REMUNERATION:

- a) Project Engineer-I will be engaged initially for a period of THREE years which may be extended up to maximum of FOUR years (including initial period of three years) based on project requirement and individual performance. Candidates will be paid a consolidated remuneration of Rs.40,000/-, Rs.45,000/-, Rs.50,000/- and Rs.55,000/- per month for thest, 2nd, 3rd year and 4 year of contract respectively.
- b) As this requirement is for above mentioned customer locations, to compensate the hardship faced by Engineers at the aforesaid locations they will be paid 10% of consolidated remuneration as Area Allowance per month.
- c) In addition to above a consolidated amount of Rs.12,000/- per year will be paid towards expenses like medical insurance premium, attire allowance, stitching charges, footwear allowance etc. The additional amount shall be paid in two installments. First installment will be processed in the first month's salary after joining and the second installment will be paid after completion of 6 months from the date of joining.

08. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 8.1 Only Indian nationals need to apply.
